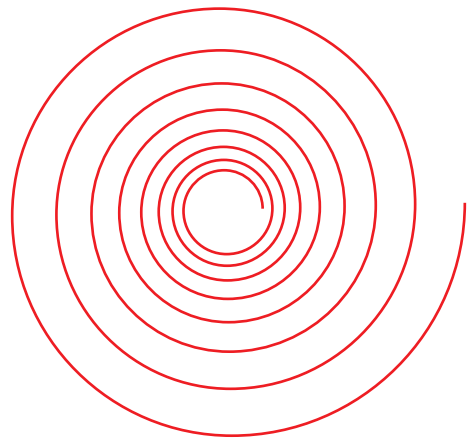
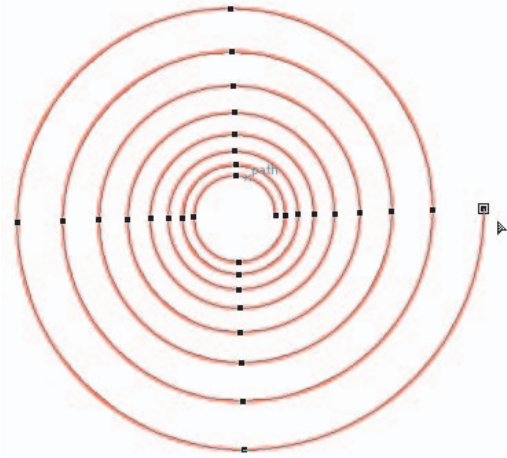


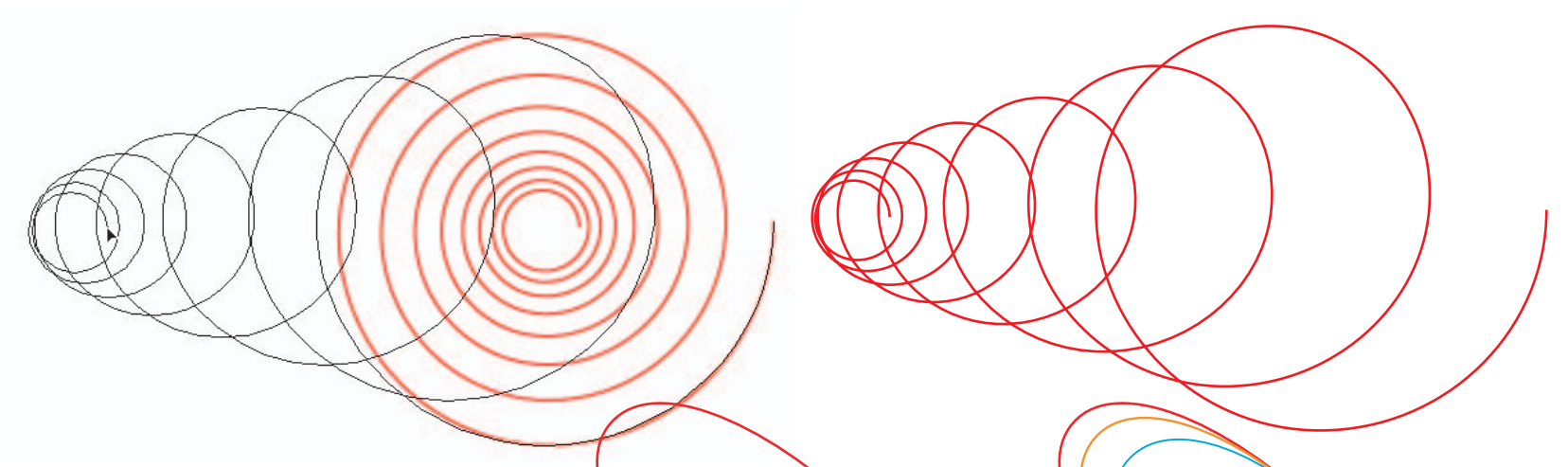
Spiral Using Reshape Tool



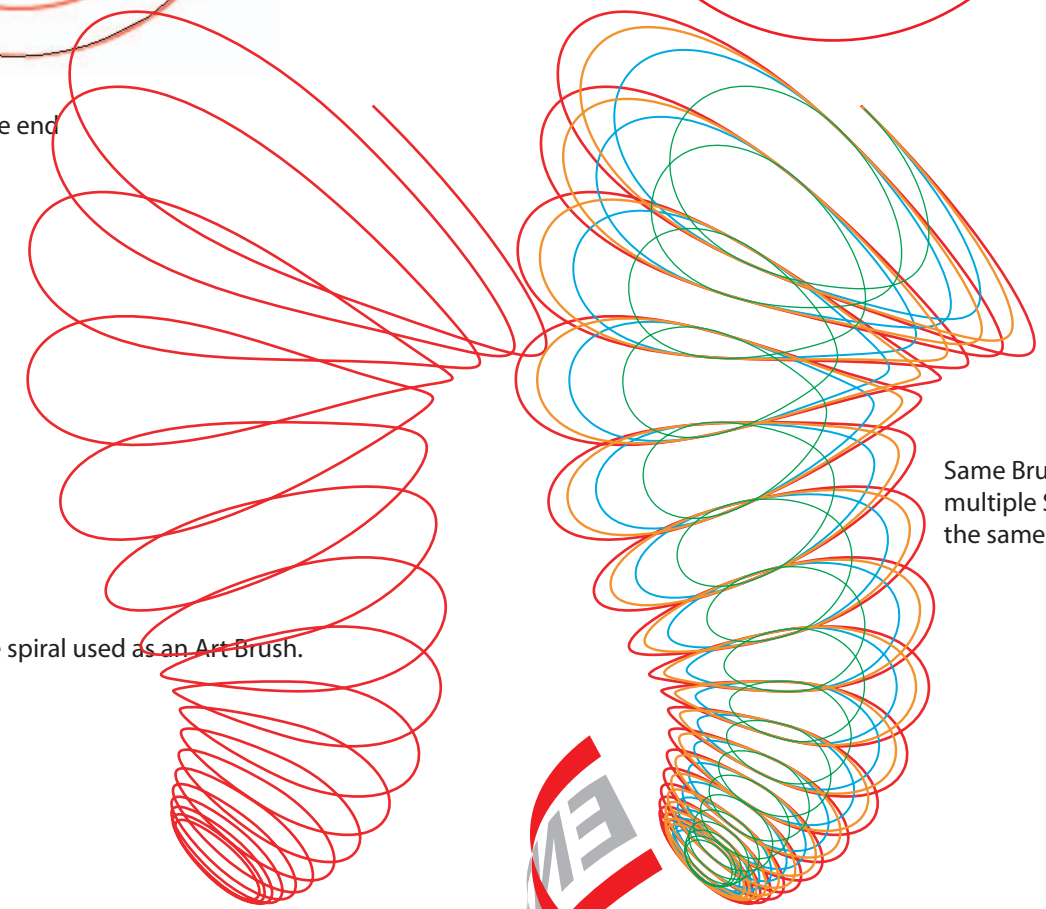
Spiral Tool. Draw a Spiral. As you drag, press the UpArrow and DownArrow keys to adjust the number of coils. Press ControlLeftBracket and ControlRightBracket to adjust the spacing of the coils.



Reshape Tool: Click one end of the spiral to make the endpoint stationary.

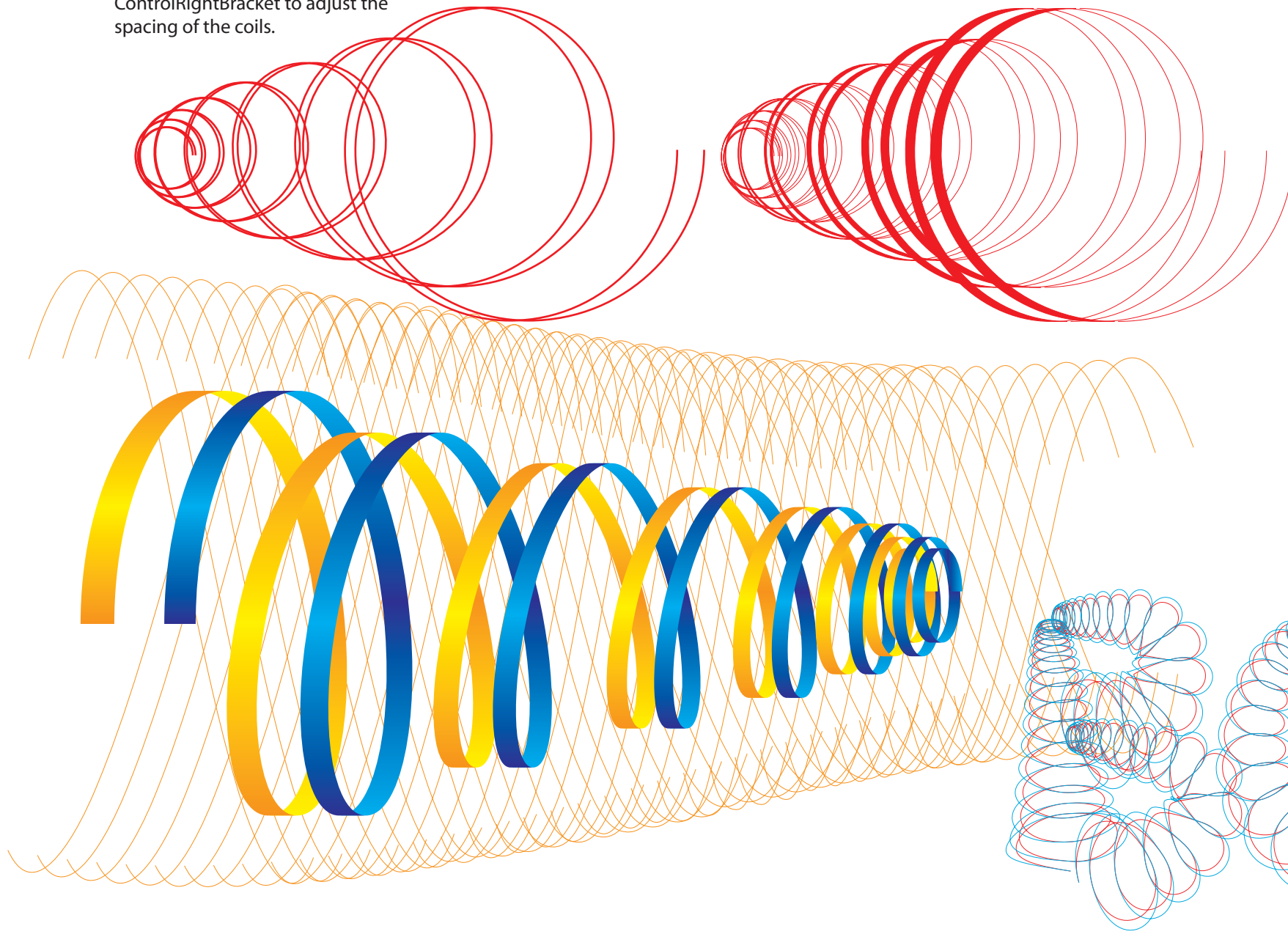


Then ClickDrag the opposite end to "stretch" the spring.



The spiral used as an Art Brush.

Same Brush applied to multiple Strokes on the same path.



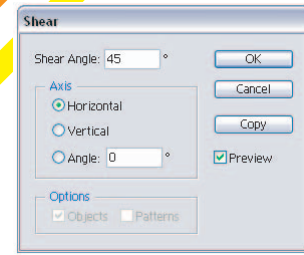
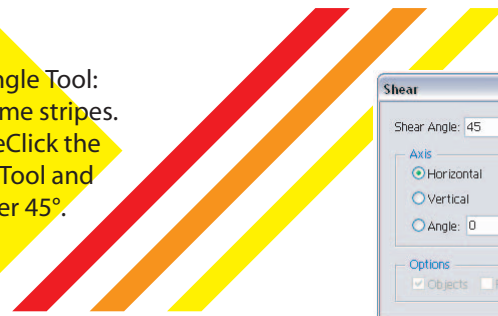

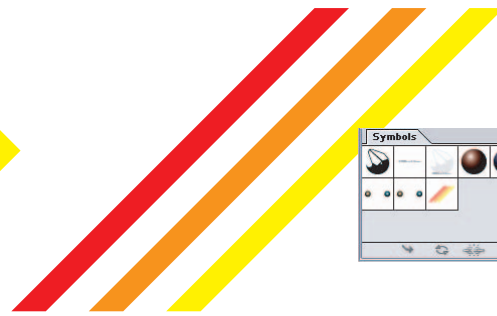
Spiral Using 3D Extrude & Mapping



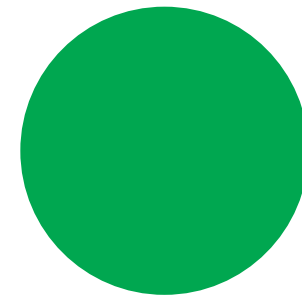
Rectangle Tool:

enter 45°.



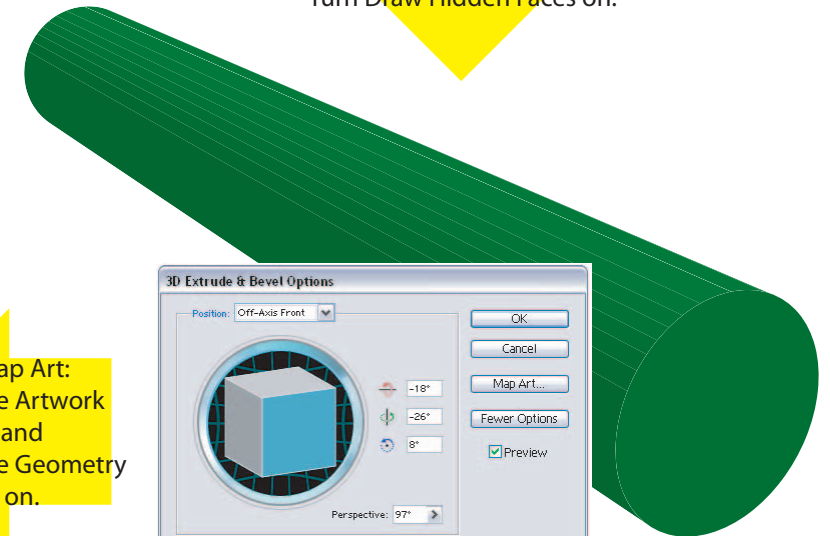
Select 'em all and

Symbol Palette.



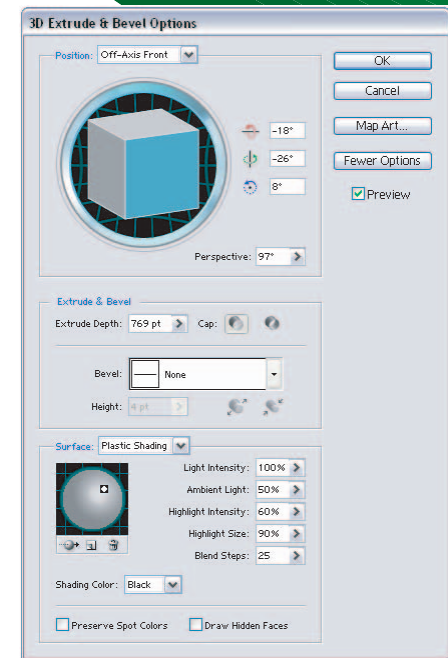
Ellipse Tool:
Draw a filled circle.



Effect: 3D: Extrude & Bevel.
Perspective, depth to taste.
Turn Draw Hidden Faces on.
